Kansas Goes Sales TAX FREE in July, 2019.

We did it! On May 16th, HB2140 was passed and signed by Governor Kelly, giving collectors, investors and dealers sales tax exemption for gold and silver coins, bullion in the form of gold, silver, platinum and palladium. Special thanks goes out to Dean Schmidt for pushing this through this year. Our club invested \$10,000 in this endeavor and it has paid off. We already have more dealers wanting to come to Kansas for our annual JCNS show in October!
